

Anders Petersen

Anders Petersen has exhibited internationally and won numerous prizes during his career. He studied photography at Fotoskolan and later at the Institute for Cinema, Radio, Television and Theatre, both in Stockholm. In 1970, he founded the group of photographers Saftra together with Kenneth Gustavsson.

Petersen is perhaps best known for his photos of the colorful, often unconventional, patrons of Café Lehmitz in Hamburg's St. Pauli, resulting in his seminal book *Café Lehmitz* (1978). Since then he has published over 20 books observing people at the margins of society.

Close to the documentary photography, Petersen created series with difficult subjects: *Fängelse* (1981 - 1983) in a prison, *Mental Hospital* (1995) in a psychiatric hospital... Since these series, Petersen has been traveling the world for his photographic project *City Diary*.
